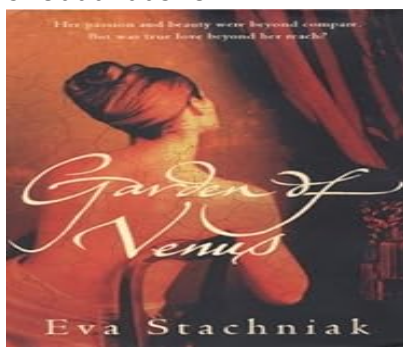


Literature Fiction Garden of venus williams
