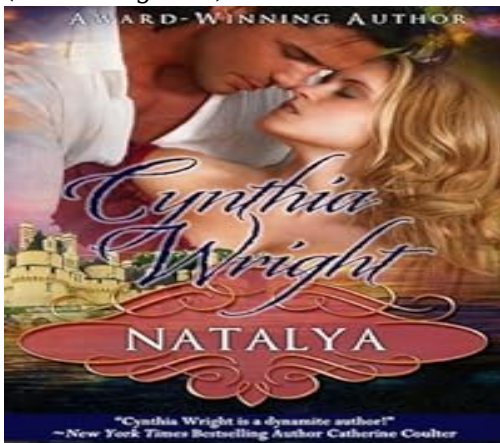

Plus once she got to England he immediately dropped her and left her to her own devices, This after swearing on his life to her uncle that he'd keep her safe and watch over her?
