Star Wars: Obi-Wan #1 rip to Rooh from the Kenobi legends book :(but also tiny youngling Obi-Wan knowing how to find the stars on Coruscant and also knowing how to use them to navigate is something so important to me :) Star Wars: Obi-Wan #1 This review discusses plot points and therefore may contain spoilers. **Starlink max capacity** Told in the form of the Jedi Master's diary entries we relive pivotal moments in Obi-Wan's life - written by Christopher Cantwell illustrated by Ario Anindito and colored by Carlos Lopez. **Star wars kindle paperwhite case** About the content In what can best be described as a flood of new content about Obi-Wan Kenobi today's first issue of the Obi-Wan comic book series shares a close release date with Mike Chen's novel Brotherhood. **Free star wars epub books** Later the live-action series starring actor Ewan McGregor will be followed by the young-adult novel Padawan resulting in what may appear as quite a confusing collection of stories that all focus on the same character. **Star wars book series** Thus this project will be particularly intriguing for most when it comes to the connections between the various works - granting possibilities that may have existed in Star Wars before (in the attempt of the Journey to Initiative for instance) but which have not really succeeded so far at least as far as the relevance of the literary stories is concerned. **Star wars qi'ra** Hence I'll be keeping a close eye on this aspect of multimedia storytelling - of course keeping in mind that each story is also supposed to stand on its own - even though it may not be until all the works are released that any discrepancies or hopefully many similarities can be found. **Star wars pdf piano** While Obi-Wan captures some of his memories in the here and now or what is the respective present of the comic we as readers experience these moments in the form of flashbacks which are backed by Obi-Wan's comments. **Star wars book series** This creates a storyline that is easy to follow throughout the whole issue never being unnecessarily complicated or convoluted rather being something that highlights a moment many readers will surely be able to relate to - albeit in a less dramatic way. **Star wars pdf rpg** The sandstorm also provides a convenient framework for the entire miniseries to give Obi-Wan a reason to tell his tales and I'm curious to see what his next memory will be inspired by. **Star wars princess leia** The characterization of present-time Obi-Wan whom we already know from the films (as far as canon is concerned) is in my opinion coherent with the story and shows life just as one would imagine that of a hermit in the desert to look like. **Star wars d6 pdf** As it turns out while Obi-Wan was liked in his Youngling clan Gehren was still his only friend - which is a nice

nod to Leia's iconic quote "You're my only hope" by the way. **Star wars ww2 references** A close friend who has visions of a parent and pursues them out of fear? As the saying goes good things come in threes and so Gehren was just the beginning of Obi-Wan's confrontations with this issue finding its dark culmination in Anakin and its balance in Luke in turn. **Starlink max capacity** It's not always easy to tell new stories about established characters that don't significantly change the perception of them while still allowing a new perspective on their journey and this first memoir has mastered the fine line between irrelevance and too obvious events for me. **Star wars convergence epub** Whether the upcoming memoirs will allude to Obi-Wan's further life as much as this one does and how they are all going to fit into the overall narrative of the aspects we already know about his life remains to be seen for now. **Star wars eu books** Of course the behavior of the younglings can be excused by considering that they are merely children but frivolously hopping through the levels of Coruscant at night in pajamas seems rather naive to me. **Star wars bookends** Gehren herself was not really brought to life as a character to me but she serves her purpose in the story before she presumably disappears into the void of secondary characters for the time being. **Star wars aurra sing** On the other side I am unfortunately less interested in how Gehren's adventure ultimately turned out but maybe that is the point of it seeing as even Obi-Wan himself seems to have gotten over it - although it being a bittersweet memory to him. **Starlink max capacity** I also enjoyed the setting: the opening sequence of the issue looks quite cinematic with the individual panels and perspectives of the planet and the artistic design does a great job of showing off Tatooine's wasteland and glaring heat. **Star wars books in order** Those who have been paying close attention may also have noticed that the Aurebesh Obi-Wan writes into his diary means some kind of end thus ending the sentence he begins in the speech box. **Star wars skeleton crew** I expected to see more air traffic and general hustle and bustle in the night sky and background of the planet but the focus on Obi-Wan and Gehren doesn't detract from the comic either. **Star wars qi'ra** Once again Anindito shows that he also has great talent for depicting non-humanoid species and I especially enjoyed the (admittedly somewhat human-like) Nodrus Cay and her appearing out of the shadows. **Star wars bookends** Conclusion Obi-Wan #1 is an interesting starting point into a multimedia story network centered around Obi-Wan Kenobi that spans over a variety of ages and literary media to of course the live-action series. **Comics star wars prix** The first issue of this miniseries is entertaining and true to the character but it remains to be seen to what extent the story will connect to the other media or whether these little anecdotes from the Jedi Master's life are meant to stand on their own. **Star wars pdf books** All in all while you might not be absolutely blown away by this story (which is definitely difficult when you already know of a character's history for the most part) the start of this series can be wholly recommended to all Obi-Wan fans and readers who like to see gaps in canon being filled!
