And indeed until I'd say 1/3 in I am having a great time and thinking this book is very solid. **Paranormal Rogue Elves of ardanin** This makes it all the more frustrating when somehow down the line characters inevitably morphed back into generic romance characters with generic problems generic doubts and a generic way to get over those!! One thing that might have made this worse is the weird triptychal structure of this book. **Book Rogue Elves of ardani goh** This was such a stupid scene: why would they had wasted time doing this while being on the run??
